

Copyright Infringement Policy

It is the policy of The Government Printing Council to comply with all intellectual property laws and to promptly investigate any notice of a claimed copyright or trademark infringement.

If you believe that any information published on this site infringes on any intellectual property rights, you must send a notice of copyright or trademark infringement containing the following information:

1. Identification of the copyrighted work or trademark claimed to have been infringed upon.
 2. A specific identification of the material on this site that is claimed to be an infringement.
 3. A statement that the individual sending the notice of infringement has a good faith belief that use of the identified material, or the manner in which the identified material is used is not authorized by the copyright or trademark owner.
 4. A statement, made “under penalty of perjury” that the information in the notice is accurate and that the party filing the notice is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright or trademark that is the subject of the alleged infringement.
 5. The address, telephone number and email address of the individual filing the notice.
 6. A physical or electronic signature of the party filing the notice must be included on the notice.
